Ridgeview Medical Center is an independent, nonprofit, regional health care network located just 35 minutes west of Minneapolis on Highway 5. Its network includes the Waconia-based acute care hospital, a multitude of primary and specialty care clinics, emergency services and specialty programs.



The 109-bed hospital, associated clinics and physicians have a well-earned reputation for clinical excellence and extraordinary service. Patients say that the Ridgeview experience is decidedly different from what they encounter at other health care facilities.

Each year, Ridgeview serves a population of approximately 300,000 people, primarily from its five-county service area of Carver, northern Sibley, southern Wright, western Hennepin and eastern McLeod. Ridgeview is one of the largest employers in Carver County, with more than 1,400 employees. It also has 450 volunteers.

NEW! da Vinci® Surgical System

The da Vinci Surgical System, a robotic platform, allows surgeons at Ridgeview to direct instruments through very small incisions. The da Vinci's seamless integration of intuitive motion, 3D high-definition visualization and fully articulating instruments provides surgeons with unparalleled precision, dexterity, control and intuitiveness.

NEW! Bariatric & Weight Loss Center

Ridgeview Bariatric & Weight Loss Center is a regional destination center for bariatric surgery, with a multidisciplinary team and comprehensive program dedicated to successful weight loss and long-term weight management.

Heart & Chest Pain Centers

The Minneapolis Heart Institute® at Ridgeview Heart Center brings advanced diagnostic technology, an outpatient clinic and catheterization lab. Ridgeview earned a three-year accreditation as a Chest Pain Center by the Society of Chest Pain Centers—a distinction held by only two other hospitals in Minnesota.

Emergency Services

Ridgeview's emergency services are supported by a broad array of high-tech equipment, including on-site diagnostic imaging, dedicated trauma bays, far-reaching ambulance services, a helicopter pad, and surgical and critical care specialists.

In our emergency room, wait times are among the best in the nation, well below the national average.

Center for Women & Children

An unmatched health care resource, Ridgeview's Center for Women & Children includes a Birthing Center and Neonatal Care Unit in partnership with Children's Hospitals and Clinics of Minnesota.

Cancer Care

Ridgeview Medical Center is committed to providing adults in the west-metro area with a comprehensive network of quality cancer care services. Preventive services including community health education and screenings, as well as diagnosis, treatment and support services, are all conveniently located on the hospital campus.

Diagnostic Imaging

A full range of advanced imaging services includes X-ray, ultrasound, diagnostic and screening mammography, stereotactic breast biopsy, bone densitometry, multi-slice CT scanning, MRI and nuclear medicine. A mobile PET scanner assists physicians in diagnosing and evaluating cancer treatments.

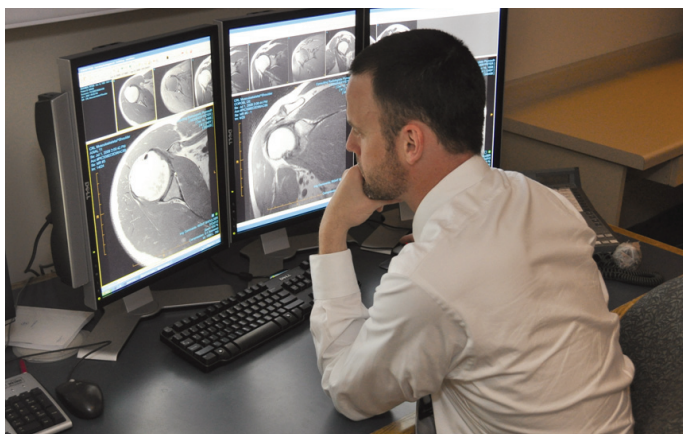
Communications Center & Ambulance

The Communications Center houses technology for Ridgeview Ambulance Service, and it serves as a backup to Carver County's main 911 system. The ambulance service provides 24/7 emergency medical care for residents across more than 700 square miles and responds to nearly 9,000 calls each year.
